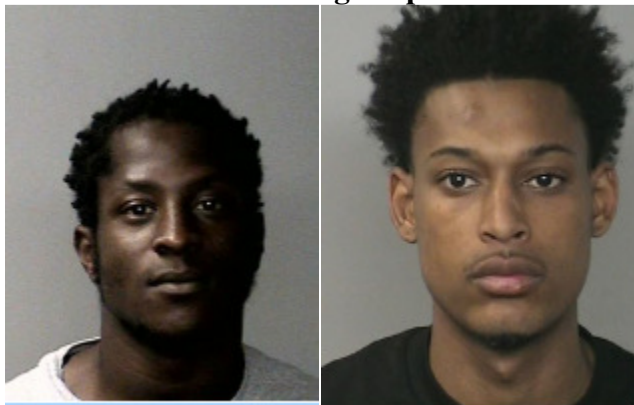

Original Release

February 12, 2019

On February 2, 2019, at approximately 1:10 A.M. the Bakersfield Police Department responded to a report of a stabbing in the 7400 block of District Blvd. The victim, AARAN PORTER (18), was involved in a large fight in the parking lot and was stabbed during the altercation. PORTER suffered major injuries as a result.

Detectives were able to identify JEREMIAH LANGSTON (24), DONNIE NOLEN (21), ARMANI BONNER (21), ISAIAH STARNs (19), and MARCUS HARRIS (34) as being involved in the assault. Detectives obtained arrest warrants for the listed subjects for attempted murder, conspiracy, and gang participation.

On February 7, 2019, detectives located MARCUS HARRIS at his residence and arrested him on his outstanding warrant. JEREMIAH LANGSTON was already in the custody of the Kern County Sheriff's Office on an unrelated charge and was arrested for his outstanding warrant.
